Program Requirements

- Be at least 18 years old at time of enrollment into Weatherization Training Program
- Reside in a distressed neighborhood or urban aid community within your County
- Possess a high school diploma or GED
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Pass a drug screen
- Score a minimum of 7th grade level on the Test for Adult Basic Education
- Demonstrate a legitimate interest in pursuing a career in the residential weatherization industry

The New Jersey Weatherization Training Program is a state recognized program dedicated to training new workers in the new and burgeoning field of environmental retrofitting and green construction. We are looking for highly motivated men and women who want more than a job, but a career. Experience is not necessary; the right attitude is.

As part of the nation's federal stimulus legislation, New Jersey is seeing an enormous increase in funding for weatherization assistance programs. The need for trained workers has never been greater. The NJWTP offers ten-weeks of comprehensive training and job-placement assistance to all participants. This program is offered at no cost to its students.

As a consortium of educators, labor unions, and community-based organizations, the NJWTP believes in offering career training, and creating job opportunities with a living wage and benefits to New Jersey Residents. NJWTP is funded in part by a grant from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development.
