The Peacemaker Tall Ship Visits Perth Amboy

PERTH AMBOY, NJ— Mayor Wilda Diaz is pleased to announce the visit of the Peacemaker, a tall ship currently traveling near the New England Coast. The ship will arrive to Perth Amboy on Monday, October 5 and will be docked at the Municipal Marina. It plans to travel to the Chesapeake Bay to meet with a fleet of tall ships, after its visit here. Their schedule is subject to change based on time and winds.

Who: The Peacemaker, Tall Ship

Time: 10:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Where: Municipal Marina

The ship is 150 feet in sparred length and 126 feet of deck with 108 feet in rig height. The peacemaker was built on a riverbank in southern Brazil by an Italian family of boat builders, using traditional methods and the finest tropical hardwoods. The ship was first launched in 1989 as the Avany, a name chosen by her designer and owner, Frank Walker, a Brazilian industrialist.
